We work closely with the Pharmacists, the community nursing team and health visitors, all based on the ground floor of the Primary Care Centre, to identify and support those at risk, vulnerable, palliative care and long term condition patients.

For the future, we are looking at ways in which we can improve our patient access; encourage the use of elearning for staff, improve our significant event reporting process, to forge closer links with other Practices in our locality groups with a view to collaborative working.
